



NEBOSH - National General Certificate (NGC)



Course Aim

This industry leading two week course provides delegates with knowledge on risk assessments and ways to control common workplace hazards such as fire, lifting and carrying, work equipment, electrical safety, hazardous substances and transport.



Who Should Attend?

Supervisors, managers and staff who have responsibility for health and safety in the workplace and need to manage risks effectively.

Many people take the NEBOSH National General Certificate as a first step in a career in health and safety - it provides a valuable overview and is a sound basis for further professional study. It is accepted by the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH) as meeting the academic requirements for Technician Membership (Tech IOSH).



Course Duration

This is a 13 day course.



Certification

Delegates successfully completing the course will be awarded a NEBOSH General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety.
