



# HSG47 - Unit 2 Familiarisation and Practical Use of SPX RD Series Locators - City & Guilds

## Course Aim

To provide delegates with the skills and knowledge required to understand and follow safe systems of work, interpret utility plans and to carry out the location of underground services in accordance with HSE HSG47, demonstrating safe working practices including the safe operation of SPX RD Series Locators.

## Who Should Attend?

Managers, Supervisors and Operatives in construction, utilities, telecommunications and petrochemical industries who are required to locate underground apparatus during planned excavations.

Managers and Supervisors required to plan and issue permits to excavate should also complete Unit 1: Managing, Planning, Surveying & Issuing of Permit as a prerequisite to attending this course.

There is a maximum number of 8 delegates for this course.
