



IOSH Managing Safely Refresher



Course Aim

To refresh manager and supervisor understanding of everyone's safety and health responsibilities in the workplace, and enable them to recognise how a safety management system helps influence, control and monitor risk to improve safety and health issues in the workplace.



Who Should Attend?

Those who manage others and manage risk and resources.

Course prerequisites

- Delegates must have completed the full Managing Safely course successfully.
- The IOSH Managing Safely certificate number will be required as evidence from the delegate prior to attendance.



Course Duration

This is a 1 day course.



Maximum Delegates

Maximum attendees: 15 delegates.

- Module two: Leadership
- Module three: Plan
- Module four: Do
- Module five: Check
- Module six: Act

Assessment: Invigilated, closed-book, multi-format question paper with explanation of pass/fail requirements. IOSH recommends delegates take a refresher course every **three years** to keep knowledge up to date.



Certification

Following the completion of the course, there will be a 6-8 week lead time for certificates to be dispatched to delegates.

1. HSS Training will mark the assessments within a two-week window.
2. HSS Training will notify the booker of any delegates who have not passed.
3. HSS Training will send a temporary certificate to those who have passed via email.
4. HSS Training will apply for the certificates via IOSH (at this point, IOSH may decide to verify the results).
5. IOSH will post the certificates to HSS Training.
6. HSS Training will forward results and a certificate.
