



Fire Responsible Person – City & Guilds

Course Aim

The aim of this course is to provide delegates with the skills and knowledge to meet their obligations within their organisation as the Responsible Person and the legal responsibilities identified in current legislation.

Through a combination of theoretical lessons and practical exercises, delegates will be better prepared to ensure a safe environment for all occupants of their buildings as well as aiming to have a comprehensive understanding of fire safety protocols and the confidence to act decisively in emergency situations.

Who Should Attend?

This course is aimed at delegates who are involved or nominated as the Fire Safety Responsible Person within a building or premise. It is designed to develop or reinforce delegates knowledge of the current legislation and compliance required.

Course Duration

This is a half a day course for virtual learning or 1 day for classroom based learning.
