

NVQ Level 3 - Diploma in Cladding Occupations

Course Aim

To provide recognition of skills and knowledge such as installing Rainscreen wall cladding systems and/or roof sheeting and cladding systems and to provide a route to achieving a Gold CSCS Trade Card.

Who Should Attend?

The NVQ: Level 3 – Diploma in Cladding Occupations qualification is aimed at those who are involved in installing Rainscreen wall cladding systems and/or roof sheeting and cladding systems that involve curved and complex roof and wall formations in the workplace, working from drawings and specifications.

It is not expected that delegates working in this industry all do the same activities or use the same equipment and machinery so the qualification has been developed to make it as widely available as possible by having 2 distinct pathways.

Certification

After Assessment, the assessor will cross-match all evidence collected with the awarding body standards and sign-off the delegate, if all standards have been met. IQA will quality check the delegate's portfolio.

Completion of this NVQ Level 3 – Diploma in Cladding Occupations will allow you to apply for a Gold CSCS Trade card.

Agenda

- Introduction to the qualification, usually taking place at an external centre – this will include paperwork for sign-up and registering with the awarding body.
- Delegates will be provided with Knowledge Packs that they may complete in their own time; identifying the delegate's current knowledge and skill set.
- Following Completion of the Knowledge Packs, the Practical Observation will begin. This will be on the learner's site, and may include visits from your assessor who will observe you working and offer support. Delegates may also be asked to record observations on camera for review by the assessor, on practical elements such as pre-shift and operation checks on the machinery.
- There will then be a collection of Witness Testimonies (from site Supervisor's / Manager's etc.) and Additional Evidence by the assessor.
- Finally, a one-to-one Professional Discussion will take place between the assessor and the delegate.
