

IMS Auditor (QHSE) Course

Course Aim

The aim of this course is to provide the knowledge and understanding of the disciplines of quality, environmental and health & safety management auditing based on the ISO 9001:2015, ISO 14001:2015 and ISO 45001:2018 standards. Delegates will learn to audit processes with an emphasis on risk-based thinking.

This course focuses delegates on the most important attributes of an IMS and helps them to understand the role of the auditor in its development and continual improvement.

This course is aimed at delegates of all experience levels. The course is aimed at those who need to be able to understand and apply recognised principles and techniques of effective management system auditing to quality, environmental and health & safety management systems.
