



HSG47 - Unit 1 Management, Planning & Surveying, Issuing of Permit - City & Guilds (Remote Learning)

Course Aim

This course outlines the dangers which can arise from work in proximity to underground services and the requirements for planning and implementing safe systems of work in order to reduce the risk.

The course is in accordance with HSE HSG47 guidance Avoiding Danger from Underground Services.

This remote learning and examination option for the market-leading [HSG47 - Unit 1 Management, Planning & Surveying, Issuing of Permit - City & Guilds](#) course has been created to allow delegates to gain and develop the required knowledge outside of the classroom.

Who Should Attend?

This course is aimed at contractors, designers, planning supervisors and others concerned with planning, organising, supervising and conducting work near underground services - including utilities, roadworks, construction and demolition work.

Certification

The trainer will conduct an online exam with all delegates via video communication on Microsoft Teams. The trainer will read out the questions and answers, and accurately record the delegates chosen answer. The delegate must be visible via the video at all times.

Delegates successfully completing the course, including the written and practical assessments are awarded a City & Guilds approved certificate.
