To allow delegates to recognise hazards, utilise control measures and safe working practices and maintain a safe working environment, concentrating on risks specifically found with working on a Petrol Filling Station.

- Understand the value of risk assessment and have the knowledge to recognise when changes to a generic assessment is required.

Who Should Attend?

Contractors working on petrol station forecourts who already hold a valid safety passport that requires renewing. This must be done in the 6 months leading up to the expiry date of their Safety Passport. If your passport has expired, you must attend the UKPIA/SPA Petrol Retail Contractors Safety Passport.

Note:

Delegates must bring their existing SPA Safety Passport card to the course. A passport sized photo is not required for the refresher course.
