



# PASMA - Towers on Stairs



## Course Aim

To provide delegates with the knowledge to safely assemble, dismantle and relocate towers on stairs without risk of personal injury to yourself or others.

Delegates must hold a current PASMA 'Towers for Users' PhotoCard and have a good working knowledge of working at height.



## Who Should Attend?

Those who need to safely assemble, dismantle and relocate towers on stairs.

### Pre-requisites

It is a requirement to attend the PASMA - Mobile Access for Tower Use course prior to attending the Towers on Stairs course.



## Course Duration

This is a 1 day course.



## Certification

Delegates successfully completing the course will receive a PASMA Certification and ID Card (valid for 5 years).
