



## Initial Verification and Certification of Electrical Installations - City & Guilds (2391-50)

### Course Aim

This course will provide delegates with the knowledge required for the initial verification of electrical installations; allowing them to be able to complete the Electrical Installation certificate and associated schedules and also the Minor Works certificate.

### Who Should Attend?

Practising electricians who have not carried out inspection and testing since qualifying or who require some update of training before going on to other City & Guilds qualifications.

The qualification is also suitable for those with limited experience of initial inspection of electrical installations, such as those entering the industry from other engineering disciplines or who have been working in allied trades.

### Course Duration

This is a 5-day course.

### Certification

Delegates successfully completing the online examination will be issued with a certification by City & Guilds.
